This event will launch an annual Sudan Day that will be hosted jointly by researchers studying ancient Sudan at Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, the Sudan Archaeological Society Berlin (SAG), the Ägyptisches Museum und Papyrussammlung (ÄMP) and the German Archaeological Institute (DAI).

For the future we plan an annual event on a weekend in mid-June in Berlin, with meetings focussing on current (field) research on ancient Sudan and on overarching topics. Besides the presentation and discussion of the various results of research at the Berlin institutions these meetings will also provide a platform for colleagues from abroad to present their research. Thus, the meetings will be held in English.
